Yes, Each unit or department At Al-Mustaqbal University College provides various services in its area to local residents, local governments, local private enterprises, and local civil and social representatives.

These units and departments carry out many societal, scientific, and cultural activities for the purpose of playing an effective role in society in addition to involving stakeholders in our decisions.

An example of these activities:

1. Al-Mustaqbal University College, provides continuous learning courses, and the Language Centre offers English language courses :

In accordance with the training development policy, MUS's Language Centre cooperates with government departments, private enterprises, and organizations to conduct annual education and training courses to meet the stakeholders' needs. The College also holds education activities for the local community and the general public to provide continuous education and learning.

The College offers various language courses enabling community residents to develop their foreign language skills. In 2020, the College offered 19 language classes, including English, and French, teaching a total of 1,000 class hours; 2000 students had completed the courses.

In 2021, Al-Mustaqbal University College encouraged county residents over age 35 to return to school. The program held two sessions of 10 weeks each in 2021, and 609 students in 19 classes completed the courses. In addition to visiting a senior citizens' home in order to teach them to read and write and eliminate illiteracy

2. Al-Mustaqbal University College also offers various continuing education courses on business operations, information technology, business management, marketing, and handicrafts enabling community residents to pursue self-growth in their areas of interest. In 2021, 700 people attended 45 classes such classes.



3. Al-Mustaqbal University College provides free medical and dental care to local residents and needy families.

At the end, the college engages with all stakeholders (local residents, governmental institutions, non-governmental institutions, and civil society organizations) by involving them in all our activities for the purpose of seeking their opinions.
