



ACCESS POLICY TO ACTIVITIES REGARDLESS OF ETHNICITY, RELIGION, DISABILITY, IMMIGRATION, STATUS, OR GENDER FOR AL-MUSTAQBAL UNIVERSITY COLLEGE

1. Purpose

Al-Mustaqbal University College (MUC) is committed to the creation and support of a balanced, inclusive, and diverse community that is open and accessible to all students, staff, apprentices, visitors, and members of the public, diversity is recognized, and there is flexibility to support differing aspirations and goals.

2. Policy Statement

4. Visitors and Members of the Public

MUC recognizes that many members of the public use the services of the University for example the Library, Theatre, and Sports Centre, or attend conferences on site, MUC takes seriously its responsibility to these people and affirms that they will be treated with respect for their rights and takes its responsibilities seriously for the safety of its community members, and visitors. Where individuals are known to pose a threat to the safety of others and will take appropriate action to protect the community, and individuals within it.
