6.2.1 Does your university as a body measure the total volume of water used in the university that is taken from mains supply, desalinated, or extracted from rivers, lakes, or aquifers?

- Yes. Al-Mustaqbal University College (MUC), as a measure to implement its [water conservation policy](#), has installed numerous water meters to measure the used volume of water consumed on campus. The installation of these meters not only provide data for the quantity of consumed water but also for the promotion of halting irresponsible water consumption as well.



- Al-Mustaqbal University College is known for its green areas and landscaping and as a result these areas require water for irrigation. The installed water meters help the engineering unit to acquire data on the efficiency of their sprinkler and drip irrigation systems used for watering these green areas. As a result, achieving the use of a minimum amount water in watering the green areas spread on the vicinity of the campus.
