Membership

The UOMUS Central Library is open for the purpose of study and research to the following groups:

- a- Members of Academic and Non-academic staff of UOMUS.
- b- Registered students of UOMUS.
- c- Graduates and retired staff members of UOMUS.
- d- Members of Academic staff of other Iraqi universities.
- e- Students of other Iraqi universities.

The UOMUS Central Library provides the following services to its users:

- a- Reference and User Education.
- b- Online Catalogs.
- c- Audiovisuals/Multimedia.
- d- Photocopy Service.
- e-printing service.
- f- Group Study Rooms.
- g- Interlibrary Document Delivery.

General Rules:

- a- All registered readers are presumed to know the Library regulations which are included in the Student handbooks and available in the Library and on the Library's web pages. Any amendments to these regulations are displayed in the Library.
- b- All members of the Library staff are authorized to inspect any books in possession of users leaving the Library.

General Behavior:

- a- Individuals 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Adults who bring children or minors into the Library are responsible for monitoring their activities.
- b- Fliers and signs Prior approval from Library Administration must be obtained before posting fliers and signs or distributing leaflets in the Library.
- c- Headphones must be used when listening to audio materials. The volume should be set at a level that ensures the sound is not audible to others.
- d- Cell phone conversations should be brief and conducted in a low voice. If an extended conversation is necessary, please go outside the telephone area or the building.

Central Library Computer Use Policy:

Public workstations in the UOMUS <u>Central Library</u> are available for research, learning, and scholarship.

- a- All members of the UOMUS community will be given priority over non-UOMUS patrons in the use of public workstations for research and learning.
- b-UOMUS students will be given first priority in the Library Reference area.
- c- UOMUS students, faculty, and staff will be required to use their ID and password to access the public workstations.
- d-Public workstations will be available with a guest login for community users and other non-UOMUS patrons.
- e-Patrons who have laptop computers can connect to UOMUS's wireless network in the library.
- f- Wireless service is reserved for UOMUS members only, if a patron is not affiliated with UOMUS and wishes to use the university wireless services;
- e- All users must adhere to the University Information and Communication Technology Policy.

Free access to Digital Library of UOMUS


