# Progress Report SDG4 2021



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## 1. Introduction

Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG4), which is related to quality education, constitutes almost an essential element to all the UN SDGs of 2030. A non-deniable fact is that education empowers people with the knowledge, skills and values to live in dignity, build their lives and contribute to their societies.

Statistics tell that more than 262 million children and youth are out of school, whereas around 750 million adults are illiterate, and thus leading to more poverty and marginalization.

Ambitions for education are essentially captured in SDG4, which aims to “ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all”. However, the roadmap to achieve the education goal provides a guideline to governments and other partners on how to turn commitments into action.

The 2030 agenda is a universal and collective commitment, which requires political determination, global and regional collaboration, the engagement of civil society, private sector, youth, the United Nation as well as the other multilateral agencies. All these institutions are required to tackle educational challenges and build systems that are inclusive, equitable and relevant to all learners. However, we should note that governments hold the main responsibility for ensuring the right to quality education.

However, it is almost confirmed by all experts of different fields that education is the magical key to a more stabilized and ideal community featured with a prosperous and happy life where there are more employment opportunities and better standard of living. In other words, education is the road to eradicating poverty and establishing a community that is almost free of social and financial sufferings.

It is remarkable to note that education in Iraq is strictly controlled by the National Iraqi Government through the Ministry of Education as well as the Ministry of Higher Education & Scientific Research. The system of education in Iraq indeed used to be one of the best in the region, but wars and conflicts that lasted for decades almost destroyed everything.

ISIS attacks in Iraq for example during the period 2014-2017 led to displacing more than six million people, and depriving children and young adults of years of education. By the end of 2019, 1.4 million people including 658,000 children are still displaced inside Iraq,<sup>1</sup> whereas almost half of the children, i.e. 355,000 do not go to school.<sup>2</sup> Moreover, the wide spread of COVID 19 and the severe drop of oil prices in the first quarter of 2020 placed more pressure on the already fragile education system.

Now we come to the role of Al-Mustaqbal University College in the processes of reconstructing the education system in Iraq, and to what extent the MUC could contribute in designing and implementing the programmes required for achieving SDG4, the UNDP goal that focuses on quality education. These programmes and activities can be summarized as follows:

1. Providing access to people (other than students) to make use of the teaching/learning equipment. Such facility can be free or subsidized.
2. Providing access to people (other than students) to attend lectures and other educational activities. This facility is always free.
3. Organizing special educational courses for people (other than students). Such facility can be free or subsidized.
4. Organizing lectures, seminars or presentations outside the university campus, at schools for example or other educational institutions.

It should be noted however that the college when organizing the programmes and activities stated above does not discriminate between people as per religion, race, gender or whether being handicapped or not.

## **2. Al-Mustaqbal University College's activates to achieve SDG4**

### **2.1 Quality Education Activities**

One of the SDG4 indicators stipulates whether the university organizes educational courses to individuals other than students. In accordance with the programs of the college related to this issue, Dr. Farah Baqir Al-Fadhili, an academic at the Media Department of Al-Mustaqbal University College has contributed in a number of outstanding activities. We list these activities with the required details and photos, and as follows: 1. A Workshop on Educational Counseling In a training workshop organized by College of Education at Kufa University, Educational Counselling Unit, Dr. Farah Baqir Al-Fadhili an academic at Al-Mustaqbal University College, Department of Media gives a lecture entitled "Ten Strategies to deal with the Sons" The lecturer has investigated the most effective methods of dealing with children along with the identification of the most important modern strategies of breeding kids. Both the workshop and the lecture have been organized as part of the College's endeavor to promote sustainability and community development. The workshop has been attended by Prof. Dr. Sirwan Al-Janabi Dean of the College of Education at Kufa University and a number of academics and administrators in the College. 2. The workshop aimed to promote community development and counselling individuals in solving mental health and family problems.



## **2.2 A Training Workshop entitled “One’s Outward Image Etiquette”**

Rehabilitation, Employment & Follow-Up Unit at Al-Mustaqbal University College in cooperation with the Holy Shrine of Al-Abbas (PUH) organizes a training workshop entitled “One’s Outward Image Etiquette” The workshop lasted for two days, the 30th of April and the 1st of May 2021, and the lecturer was Dr. Farah Baqir Al-Fadhili who investigated in her lecture the management of one’s outward appearance, defining it as a science and an art, which combines dress, personal grooming, body language all together with etiquette and vocal communication skills. Management of personal appearance is so vital for creating the first positive impressions as an important step towards achieving one’s career aspirations. The lecturer clarified that 90% of the impression is composed during the first 20 seconds of contact with people we meet for the first time. According to Amy Cody, a social psychologist at Harvard Business School, a person often leaves two impressions among others and not just one. People work on determining the reliability of the person they meet as well as his intentions that shall lead to doubt or trust. These two characteristics, i.e. reliability and trust, constitute 80 – 90 percent of the first impression. The workshop included lots of discussions, comments and inquiries raised by participants as well the lecturer.



### **2.3 Part of the activities program in which training workshops are held outside Al-Mustaqbal University College, the Department of Pharmacy in cooperation with the Administration of Health in Babylon has organized an attendance workshop entitled “COVID 19 Vaccination & its Impact on Our Life”**

The Department of Pharmacy at Al Mustaqbal University College, and in cooperation with the Administration of Health in Babylon has organized an attendance workshop under the title “ COVID19 Vaccination & its Impact on Our Life”. The aim that lies behind organizing this workshop is to encourage people to take the vaccine so that life can retrieve its normal status. The workshop has been attended by Prof. Dr. Hasan Shakir Majdi, Dean of Al-Mustaqbal University College as well as a large number of academics representing the different departments of the College. The workshop has focused on a number of issues including • What is vaccine? • How is it manufactured? • Types of vaccines and features of each one • Their effectiveness The lecturers have emphasized that taking the vaccine is an important procedure, in addition to other preventive ones, so as to ensure protection against the virus, adding that complying with the general health prevention procedures, such as washing hands with soap, using sterilizers, wearing masks and keeping distance when communicating with others is highly required even after taking the vaccine.
