Nouns and Adjectives



What is the difference between
nouns and adjectives?

NOUN VERSUS ADJECTIVE

Noun is a word that identifies person, place, object or idea.

Nouns can act as subjects or objects in a sentence.

Nouns can be found anywhere in a sentence.

A noun can occur alone in a sentence.

Adjective is a word that modifies a noun.

Adjectives can act as modifiers.

Adjectives can be found before or after a noun.

An adjective cannot exist alone.
