11.1 Can

Positive:

Subject + can + base verb

Example:

I can swim.

They can run fast.

Negative:

Subject + can't + base verb

Can + not → Can't

Example:

We Can't play golf.

He Can't speak English well.

Question

1. Questions with question words (Wh-q)

Wh-q + can + subject+ base verb?

Example:

When can I go home?

What can you do?

2. Yes/No Questions and short answers

Can + subject + base verb?

Example:

Can I go home?

Can you swim?

Grammar

12.1 Would like

We use would like :

- To ask for things:

Ex: I'd like a magazine, please.

We'd like a cup of tea, please.

- In questions to offer things:

Ex: Would you like some cake? Yes, please

Would you like a drink? No, Thank you

- With another verb:

Ex: Would you like to go out tonight?

What would you like to do?

12.2 Like and would like

1-We use like and like doing to talk about things we always like.

Ex: I like coffee.

She likes swimming in summer.

What do you like doing at the weekend?

2- We use would like to talk about things we want now.

Ex: I'd like a cup of tea.

She's hot. She'd like to go swimming.

***if the subject was singular (She, He, It), we add (s) to like**

Ex: She likes a cup of tea.

12.3 Would like and want

We use would like, not want, when we want to be polite.

Ex: I'd like a coffee, please.
