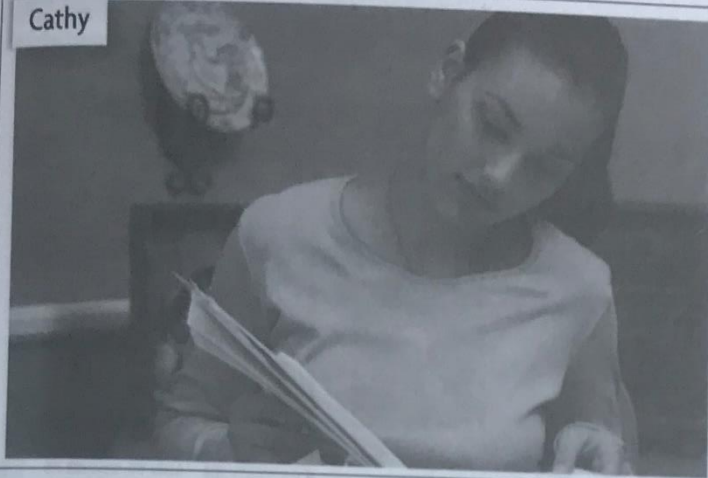


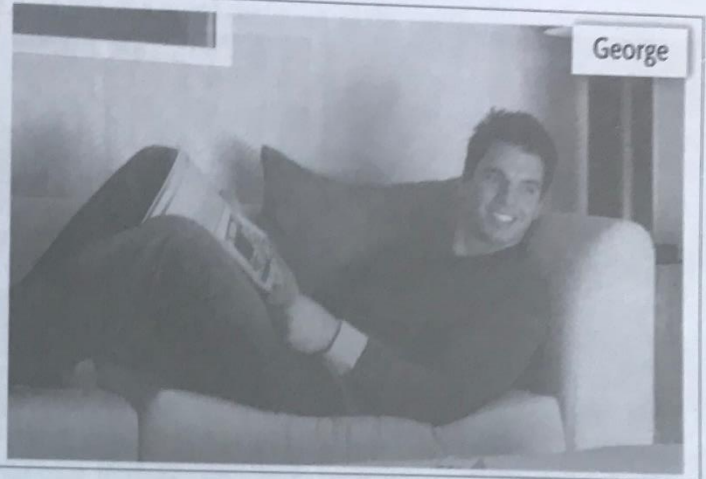

Michelle is an attorney (an American lawyer). She doesn't work now her husband is President. She says her most important job is as mother to their children.

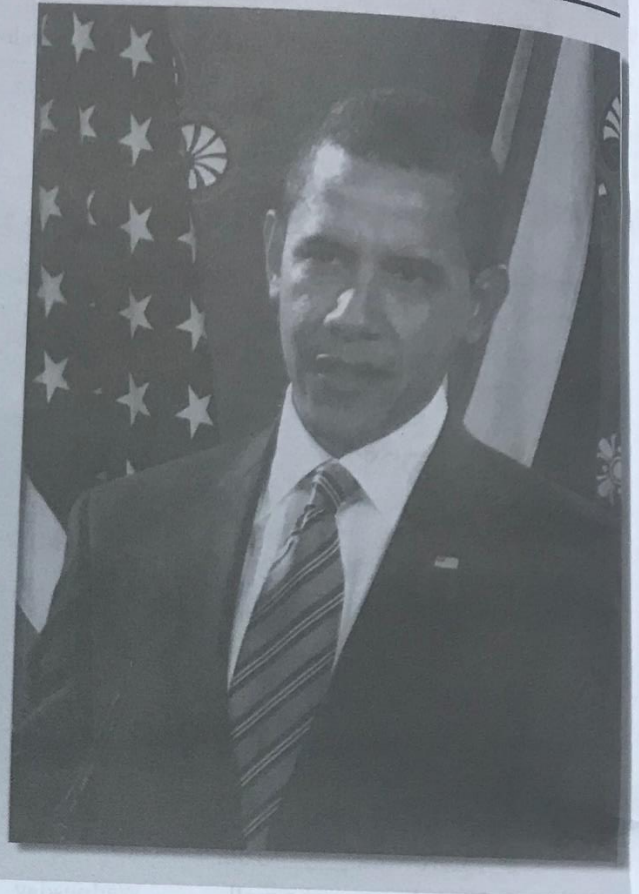
His interests Barack Obama loves basketball. He has his own indoor basketball court in the White House, and he often invites professional basketball players to come and play with him.

His home The President and his family live in the White House. It has 132 rooms. One hundred people work for him. His chefs make his favourite food - chili and pasta.

His work Mr Obama works in the Oval Office in the White House. He often works more than sixteen hours a day.
