

Present perfect usage


We use the present perfect to describe something that started in the past and continues in the present.





Present perfect usage

 Use the present perfect to express that action that has repeatedly happened in the past.



Example: They have traveled to Spain several times.

Subject + have / has + past participle

I You He She It




We They The people Everyone

KEY WORDS FOR PRESE PERFECT

Already = (adv.) before now

I have already finished my homework.

Not yet = (adv.) not before now

Scientists have not yet discovered a cure.
