


Infection Process

- Pathogens
 - Microorganisms that produce disease
- Infection
 - Invasion and multiplication of microorganisms
 - Results in injury



Chain of Infection







Chain of Infection

- Agent, host, and environment
 - Biological agents
 - Chemical agents
 - Physical agents
 - Susceptible host
 - Compromised host





Chain of Infection

- Modes of transmission
 - Contact
 - Airborne
 - Vehicle
 - Vector-borne



Normal Defense Mechanisms

- Nonspecific immune defense:
 - Skin and normal flora
 - Mucous membranes and sneeze, cough, and tearing reflexes
 - Elimination and acidic environment
 - Inflammation





Normal Defense Mechanisms

- Specific immune defense:
 - Humoral immunity
 - Acquired immunity
 - Vaccination



Stages of the Infectious Process

- Incubation period
- Prodromal stage
- Illness stage
- Convalescent stage



Hygiene

- Factors influencing hygienic practice:
 - Body image
 - Social and cultural practices
 - Personal preferences
 - Socioeconomic status
 - Knowledge
