

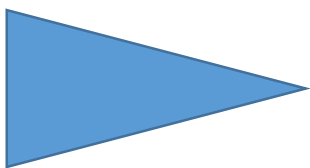

5 What do you want to do?

Verb patterns 1 • Future forms

1. Like doing and would like to do

To express general enjoyment, we use

(Like/love+ v-ing).

e.g. She **loves** drawing flowers.

- To express preferences at a specific time, we use

(would +like/love +to + v.)

e.g. He would **like** to **be** a doctor. (when he grows up)

2. (will/going to) Future Intentions

- To express about 1) future intention 2) offer which made at the time of speaking, we use **(Will + infinitive Verb)**.

for example: 1. I will **read** your book.

2. I will **carry** it for you

- To express about * a future intention/ plan which made **before** the time of speaking, we use

(sub. + going+ to + infinitive Verb).

for example: 1. He **is** going to **do** a birthday party.

2. They **are** going to **stay** in England.

verb pattern 1

Here are four pattern verb:

1- Verb + to + infinitive

I'd like to go aboard.

2- Verb + - ing

He finished reading his book.

3- Verb + - ing or Verb + to + infinitive with no change in meaning.

It began to rain / raining

4- Verb + preposition + - ing

we're thinking of moving house.

I'm looking forward to having more free time.

am/is/are + going to + to + infinitive
