
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HYPOTHYROIDISM

- HYPOTHYROIDISM

- Insufficiency synthesis of thyroid hormones.
- Female: Male ratio is 6: 1.
- Causes:
 - Hashimoto's thyroiditis
 - Thyroid failure following radio iodine.
 - Surgical treatment of thyrotoxicosis.
 - Drugs like carbimazole, amiodarone.
 - lodine deficiency.
- Signs and symptoms
- •Weight gain.
- •Enlarged thyroid gland.
- •Depression.
- Fatigue.
- Bradycardia
- Constipation

- Decreased reflexes
- Cold intolerance



- Ophthalmologic features:

- Periorbital swelling (part of the generalized nonpitting skin edema of myxedema).
- Characteristic loss of the outer third of the eyebrow.
- Open-angle glaucoma (deposition of a mucopolysaccharide within the trabecular meshwork).



- Diagnosis

- TSH ---elevated
- T3 & T4 levels----low.
- Presence of antibodies

- Treatment

• Thyroxine .
