Steps of the planning process

The most important steps in the planning process in organizations are:

Decision Making:-

Is the process of identifying and solving problems.

Types of Decisions

The most important types of decisions in organizations are:-

1- Organizational and personal decisions

Organizational decisions are made by managers while personal decisions relate to individual goals.

2- Programmed and Non Programmed decisions

- **Programmed decisions** are repetitive and well defined to decisions problem .
- Non Programmed decisions are novel and poorly defined and no procedures exist for solving the problems.

Departmentalization
