

The present simple tense

The present simple tense is used in English to express habitual actions, general truths, or facts that are always true.

يستخدم زمن المضارع البسيط في اللغة الإنجليزية للتعبير عن الأفعال المعتادة أو الحقائق العامة أو الحقائق التي تكون صحيحة دائمًا.

Affirmative Form: حالة الاثبات

- For most verbs, use the base form of the verb.
- Add an "-s" or "-es" to the third person singular (he, she, it).

Examples:

- I eat lunch at 12:00 every day.
- She reads a book before bedtime.

Negative Form: حالة النفي

- Use the auxiliary verb "do" (does for third person singular) + "not" (do not/doesn't) + the base form of the main verb.

Examples:

- I do not (don't) like coffee.
- He doesn't (does not) play soccer.
