The present continues tense

1. The definition of Present continues tense .

The **present continuous** verb tense indicates that an action or condition is happening now, frequently, and may continue into the future.

يشير الفعل المضارع المستمر إلى أن الفعل يحدث الآن ، بشكل متكرر ، وقد يستمر في المستقبل

The present continuous tense is one which is commonly used within the English language and often uses the (-ing) form of a verb, for example 'she is running.' We can see that the sentence is happening *continuously* in the present moment.

المضارع المستمر هو الذي يستخدم بشكل شائع في اللغة الإنجليزية وغالبًا ما يستخدم صيغة (ing-) من الفعل ، على سبيل المثال "she is running ". يمكننا أن نرى أن الجملة تحدث باستمر ار في الوقت الحاضر.

2. Present Continuous Tense Structure

Basically, the Present progressive tense is formed by adding (-ing)to the base verb.

The structure of the Present Continuous Tense is:

<u>S + am/is/are + V-ing +....</u>

بشكل أساسي ، يتم تشكيل الفعل المضارع التقدمي عن طريق إضافة ing إلى الفعل الأساسي.

Examples:

- I am going to school.
- He is playing GTA 5
- You are dancing on *the Nagin song*.
- She is watching a movie in the theatre.
- It is raining cats and dogs.
- We are playing in the park.

3.How we make negative sentences

In the present continuous tense, negative forms are made using NOT.

NOTفي المضارع المستمر ، تُكون صيغة النفي باستخدام

<u>S + am/is/are (not) + V-ing +...</u>

Examples a bout negative sentences

- She isn't cooking.
- he isn't watching TV at the moment.
- I'm not using the dictionary.
- I'm not working this weekend.
- She isn't going to school next week.
- They're not improving the situation.

- He is not going to work again.
- I'm not getting better at English.
- I'm not always doing homework.
- She isn't looking for a job now.
- They are not cooking at the moment.
