


Selecting the Correct Irregular Verb


Review of Regular Verb Spelling Rules

Add ed	Start <u>ed</u> , finish <u>ed</u> , wash <u>ed</u> , help <u>ed</u> , listen <u>ed</u> , watch <u>ed</u>
Verbs ending in e, add only d	Liv <u>ed</u> , car <u>ed</u> , di <u>ed</u> , dat <u>ed</u> , shar <u>ed</u>
Change the y to i and add ed	Dried, cried, fried, married, spied
Don't change the y to i just add ed	Pray <u>ed</u> , play <u>ed</u> , stay <u>ed</u> , destroy <u>ed</u>
CVC rule: double the final consonant & add ed	Stopp <u>ed</u> , robb <u>ed</u> , lobb <u>ed</u> , napp <u>ed</u>
Do not double final w or x , just add ed	Wow <u>ed</u> , mix <u>ed</u> , jinx <u>ed</u> , meow <u>ed</u> , vow <u>ed</u> ,
Two syllables, and the 2 nd is stressed, double the final consonant and add _{ed}	Remitt <u>ed</u> , permitt <u>ed</u> , admitt <u>ed</u> , occurr <u>ed</u>
Two syllables, and the 2 nd is not stressed, don't double the final consonant, just add ed	Happen <u>ed</u> , listen <u>ed</u> , open <u>ed</u> , earn <u>ed</u> ,


