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Title: What is a Topic Sentence?

Subtitle: Understanding its Role in Paragraphs

Definition of a Topic Sentence

"A topic sentence is a sentence that expresses the main idea or central point of a paragraph."

Emphasize that it often appears at the beginning of a paragraph.

Characteristics of a Topic Sentence

Clarity: Clearly states the main idea of the paragraph.

Unity: Keeps the paragraph focused on a single topic.

Coherence: Helps to connect the paragraph to the overall theme of the writing.

Examples of Topic Sentences

Example topic sentences from various types of writing:

Expository: "The benefits of regular exercise extend beyond physical health."

Narrative: "The trip to the amusement park was filled with unexpected adventures."

Argumentative: "Increased taxation on sugary beverages can help combat obesity."

Functions of Topic Sentences

Signal the beginning of a new idea or paragraph.

Provide a roadmap for the reader, indicating what to expect in the paragraph.

Help maintain the overall organization and coherence of the writing.

Importance of Topic Sentences in Writing

Essential for organizing and structuring paragraphs effectively.

Aid in comprehension for the reader by clearly stating the main idea.

Contribute to the flow and logical progression of ideas throughout the text.
