

private and public life. The machinery of legislation is therefore the easiest and most effective means for realizing this end.

**Advantages of Legislation.** The advantages of legislation may be stated briefly as follows:-

- 1 — **Clarity.** By legislative enactments, the legislative organizes to the citizens the rules which are henceforth to be considered as rules of law, normally, in an easy language.
- 2 — **Speed.** A change in the law is effected by the simple process of repeal and substitution of new rules. The astonishing speed of this process can be seen if it is compared with the circuitous and tedious methods by which changes in the law were brought about in earlier times.
- 3 — **Universality.** Once legislation is put into effect, its rules become the governing law in all parts of the legislating countries. Thus, the governing rule is one and the same irrespective of localities.
