
#### How do we use the Past Perfect Tense?

The past perfect tense expresses action in the past before another action in the past. This is the past in the past.

#### **EXAMPLE**:

The train left at 9am. We arrived at 9.15am. When we arrived, the train had left.

#### The Past Perfect



The Titanic <u>had received</u> many warnings before it hit the iceberg.

I had already eaten when my friend stopped by to visit.

#### He came to my house.

Simple Past Tens

I had already left.

#### Past Perfect Tense

He came to my house after

After I had already left, he came to my house.
He came to my house after I had already left.

I had already left.

after
as soon as {had+PP}

, Past simple

#### What had Ali done before he went fishing

# Ali had repaired his car before he went fishing.
