Positive & Negative

When the sentence is **positive**, it means it is affirmative.

e.g. I like Ice-cream

e.g She likes pizza

e.g Do you like ice-cream?

When the sentence is **negative**, it means it is non-affirmative

e.g. I don't like ice-cream

e.g. They don't like pizza

Don't you like ice-cream?

Adjectives before Nouns

Note: don't add (s) to adjectives, but to nouns

Spanishes Orange (X)
